

Citrus Tree Rules

Up to three citrus trees may be planted on either the side or back yards of a home. They must be maintained by the homeowner.

What WILL be cited:

- Fruit left on the ground (Residents must keep the ground clear of fallen fruit)
- Dead or dying trees
- Trees planted in the front yard

It is the responsibility of part time or seasonal residents to have their trees maintained in their absence.
