

Mailbox Rules Cleaning – Repair - Maintenance

The mailboxes and posts are constructed of cast aluminum. They must be cleaned with mild detergent and water or an all-surface cleaner that does not contain chlorine or ammonia. The manufacturer recommends mailboxes and posts be sprayed with liquid spray auto wax three or four times each year to protect the finish. Cleaning and sanitizing of the mailboxes and posts are the responsibility of property owners or residents.

Repair and/or replacement of components of the mailboxes and posts are the responsibility of the Waterford Master Owners Association. If a property owner or resident identifies damage to their mailbox or post, they should call the WMOA Office 941-484-8879 to report damage.
