

Flag Pole Policy.

All homeowners per FL HOA State Statute Chapter 720.304 may display one portable, removable United States Flag. However, the flag must be displayed in a respectful manner, consistent with Title 36 U.S.C. Chapter 10 of the Florida Statutes. The following rules will apply to permanent Flag poles:

1. United States, U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, or POW-MIA Flags only permitted.
2. The flagpole must be made of two-inch silver aluminum and be no more than 20 feet or less than 16 feet in height measured from the finished ground level.
3. Only gold or silver balls on top.
4. The sleeve placed in the ground that holds the flagpole can be aluminum or PVC. The sleeve cannot extend more than three inches above the ground.
5. The flag cannot exceed 4 ½' x 6' in size.
6. Per the Association's Declaration of Restrictions – Article 3: owner must submit an Exterior Modification Request to the Board to approve before installation. This form can be found on the AMI website.
